Criteria

- Commitment to personal education, training and accreditation.
- Demonstrate a high level of professionalism and industry representation.

Applications must be emailed and include:

- Candidate background.
- Statement of marine industry experience.
- A statement describing future plans for service in the industry.
- List of all relevant qualifications and certificates.
- Provide two professional referees in writing.
